

## Collection of 24-hour urine sample for Urinary Oxalate

### Patient information sheet

*You may find it convenient to collect the urine over a weekend to avoid having to take the container to work with you.*

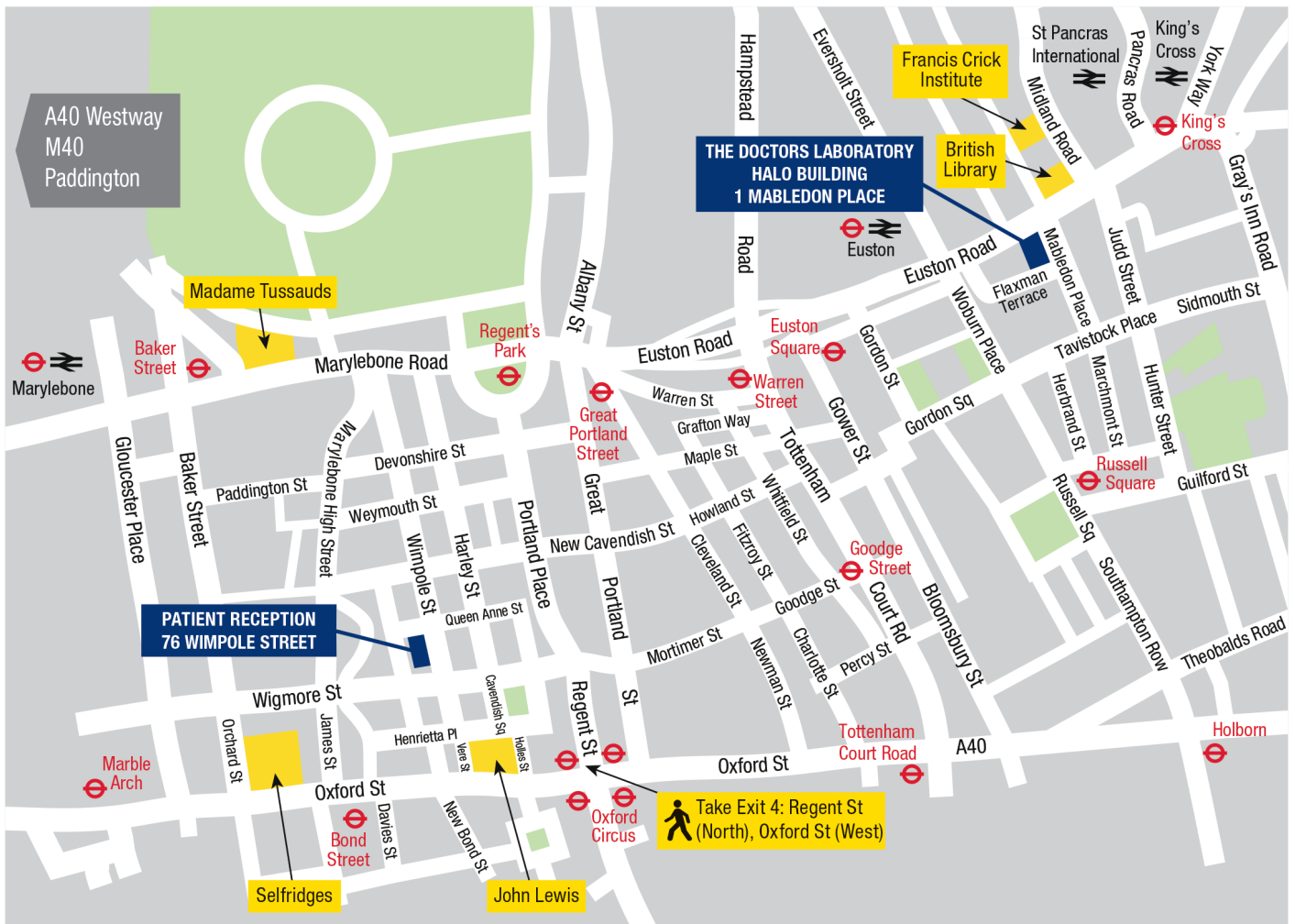
- 1 Do not collect the first urine sample of the day. For example, go to the toilet as normal.
- 2 Collect the second urination of the day and all urine samples for the next 24 hours in the container provided. For example: from **08:00AM** to **08:00AM** the next day.
- 3 Please label the container with the following: Patient name, DOB, Date of sample, Sex, Date and time of collection and Volume.
- 4 Store container in a cool place, preferably a refrigerator.
- 5 Keep the container upright during collection.
- 6 Place the container in the specimen bag provided.
- 7 Please return the sample with the request form to the Laboratory.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

For 3 days prior to and during the collection you must avoid rich sources of vitamin C and the following:

• Cucumbers • Rhubarb • Asparagus • Spinach • Tomatoes

If you are on any medication please give the Phlebotomist/Receptionist/Laboratory full details when you return your sample.
